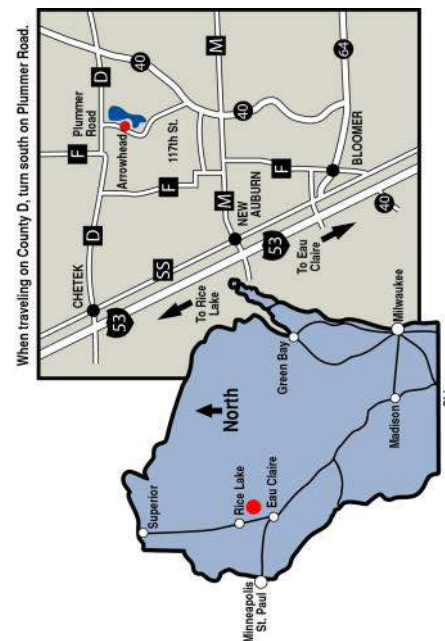

BASIC July 1-13
grades 9-12

This intense two-week experience will have you digging deeply into God's Word and practicing your servant-leadership as we look together at the true nature of being a disciple of Jesus Christ. Because of its intentionally smaller group size, BASIC allows for more one-on-one time with staff as well as rich relationships among students.

HOMEBASE June 10-27
grades 9-12

For students who have completed BASIC, HomeBase is the unique opportunity to spend three weeks at camp learning more about your specific spiritual gifts, passions, strengths, and weaknesses, as well as learning intensive Bible-study techniques. On top of that, you'll learn more about ministry at Arrowhead, and then be placed in cabins to counsel alongside of one of our summer staff.

Scholarship help is available. We would like all children to have the opportunity to attend camp. If finances are a problem, please check with your church first for assistance. If you do not attend a church, or if funds are not available there, please contact Arrowhead to inquire about scholarship funds.

Early Bird Discount: If your registration is postmarked on or before April 1, you will receive \$20 off. If your registration is postmarked on or before May 1, you will receive \$10 off.

Family Discount: If you are registering more than two children from your home for camp this summer, you will receive an additional \$25 off for the registration fee for your third child.
