ARRIVAL AND TRAINING

When you arrive, we will have a staff meeting so that we can all get to know the staff a bit better. Afterward, we will give you a brief orientation concerning your work for the week. This summer's theme is **We Will Rise**, based out of Romans 6:8 which reads "Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him."
