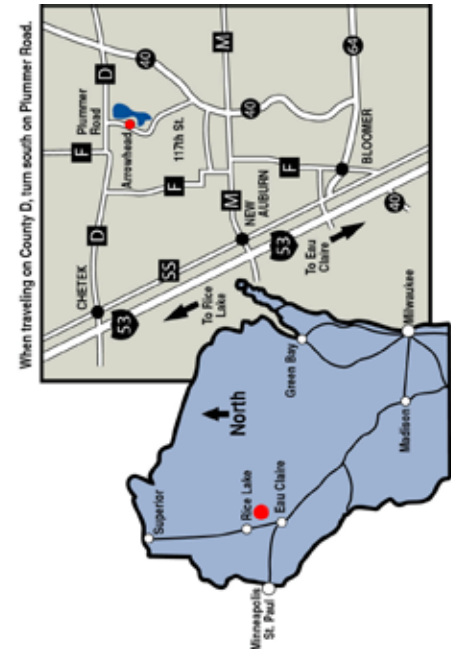

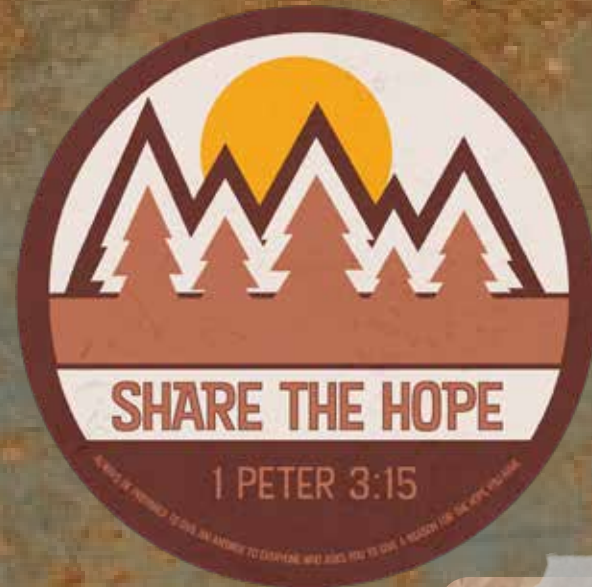

## EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT

If your registration is postmarked on or before April 1st, you will receive \$20 off. If your registration is postmarked on or before May 1st, you will receive \$10 off.

## FAMILY DISCOUNT

If you are registering more than two children for camp from your home this summer, you are eligible for an additional \$25 off the registration price for your third child or more. ## BASIC

Grades 9–12 | June 7–19 | \$623

Because of its intentionally smaller group size, BASIC allows for more one-on-one time with staff as well as rich relationships among students.

For students who have completed BASIC, HomeBase is the unique opportunity to spend three weeks at camp learning more about your specific spiritual gifts, passions, strengths, and weaknesses, as well as learning intensive Bible-study techniques. On top of that, you'll learn more about ministry at Arrowhead, and then be placed in cabins to counsel alongside of one of our summer staff.
