Arrowhead Bible Camp is located on beautiful Chain Lake in Chippewa County of Wisconsin.

Our History

Arrowhead Bible Camp was established in 1974, but its history goes back many years before that. The Arrowhead program began in 1939 as a one-week youth camp utilizing a facility in the Chetek, WI area, and in the years that followed, the program continued trading off between a couple different camps in the Chetek area. The current property on Chain Lake was purchased in 1976 because the need for a youth camp program had "outgrown" the rental sites available. The property, originally consisting of 39 acres, was a fishing resort that had been in use during the warmer months. The Lodge (which now contains our dining hall, office, and several dormitory units) was built in 1896 by a Civil War veteran, and it is still standing to this day! The camping season gradually grew through the years, and Arrowhead now consists of 72 beautiful acres, thirteen buildings, and a year-round ministry reaching many children, adults, and families with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Our Core Values

We value each individual person because they were made in God's image and Christ died for them. We encourage each individual to trust in Christ, to become His obedient follower, and then become a servant-leader. We treasure the Bible as our only authority, which guides all our activities and teaching.
