Staff Training

Staff training is 2:00pm on Friday, May 22nd, through Friday, June 5th. You must attend all of staff training. Staff will have off on Tuesday June 2. In these weeks we hope to equip you for your job, build you up spiritually, and mold our team into a unified staff family!



Summer Schedule

Generally your workweek is Sunday, 1pm through Friday, 2pm. One week of June and the last two weeks of August there will be rental groups at camp. In these weeks job positions will be divided into Dish Crew, Cooks, Maintenance, and Lifeguards. In August you will be required to work a Saturday, but you will get another day off sometime during the week. When you are not working (weekends generally) you can stay at camp if you'd like, but meals will not be provided. PLEASE plan to rest on weekends along with doing whatever plans you make. We expect you to attend a church in the area on the weekends as well.



Summer Theme

Our theme this year is "Renewed," drawn from Psalm 51:10: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me."

Many young people wrestle with guilt, shame, discouragement, or the fear that failure puts them on the sidelines of the Christian life. Psalm 51 reminds us that God meets us in our brokenness and brings us back into fellowship, purpose, and fruitfulness.

Our desire is that campers leave knowing that God is not done with them—even when they stumble. Renewal is not a one time moment but a daily grace through which God shapes us into the likeness of Christ.

SUMMER *Packing List*

You will be living at camp for three months, so be sure to pack accordingly. You will be sleeping in a bunk bed, and your storage space will be under and alongside this bed. You will be in the same location for a majority of the summer, but will move locations several times as well, so pack in a way that is easy to unpack/repack as needed.



Essential Items

- Passport OR Social Security Card and ID (so you can get paid :P)
- Water bottle
- Shower towel & beach towel
- Shower caddy, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, & toothpaste
- Backpack (for daily items: Bible, water bottle, schedule...)
- Bible, notebook, & pens/pencils
- 1 or 2 flashlights
- Insect repellent and sunscreen
- Laundry detergent
- Plastic bin under 9.5in tall (all food must be kept in covered bins in the pantry)
- Pillow, twin sheets & blankets. Sleeping bag (necessary for Discipleship Counselors)
- Several bandanas
- Fan
- Plastic 3 drawer storage
- Age-appropriate devotionals, games, F.O.B. activities



Clothes

- Casual clothing
- Active clothing (including 1 red and 1 blue shirt)
- Clothes that can get dirty/muddy
- 1-2 nice outfits
- Modest swimwear (see Summer Staff Procedures)
- Tennis shoes & Sandals
- Raingear
- Sunglasses/hat



Optional Items

Snacks for the week, camera, musical instruments you play, fishing gear, books, ball/frisbee, art supplies, cabin decorations (posters, lights...), lamp, side table
